Minutes of the Monthly POA Board of Directors meeting on January 25, 2025

- 1. <u>Call to order</u>. President Pat O'Kelley called the meeting to order at 9:00 a.m. Nate Meleen gave the invocation.

## 3. Community Reports.,

- a. <u>SDCRWA</u> by Flint Ridge POA representative Brian Snyder. Uneventful period. The Water Board is now meeting quarterly instead of monthly. One water line was repaired in RV 2.
  - b. Fire Department by Mike Hope. 7 medical calls, 3 mutual aid calls.
- c. <u>Security</u>: by Officer Dean Clark. 66 total calls for December and January. 5 Suspicious car/persons; 7 Tailgating; 4 Misuse of gate card; 8 Traffic stops; 1 Trespassing; 11 Dog calls; 2 Welfare check/county escort; 10 Medical/fire calls; 5 Disturbances; 12 Resident concerns.
  - d. Beautification Team -- Lew Story. No activity cold weather.

# 4. Committee Reports

- a. <u>ACC</u> by Theresa Meglasson. 18 permits were issued. 3 New houses have been started; 3 New houses are being built; 1 Tree removal; 2 Carport/RV/Patio Cover; 2 Deck placement, repairs, removal; 2 Miscellaneous renovations; 3 Shed/Portable storage bldg.; 1 RV placement; 3 Manufactured home placements; 1 Propane tank placement.
- b. <u>Violations Hearing Committee</u> by Mike Hope. 2 Misuse of gate cards and 1 speeding violation were considered.
- 5. **Minutes**. Mike Hope moved that the minutes for December 7, 2024 be approved as distributed; duly seconded and carried.

#### 6. **Treasurer's Report** by Treasurer Mike Hope.

December. We began the month with cash in bank of \$301,059. During the month we had cash receipts of \$172,405 from all departments. Total income for the month was \$36,584 over the budgeted amount. Net Balance Sheet adjustments were (\$60,292). During the month our operating expenses were \$146,866. This amount was \$11,270 under budget. We ended the month with cash in bank of \$266,307 which was a decrease of \$34,752.

Mike Hope moved for approval of the Treasurer's report; duly seconded and carried.

7. **Suspension of Member's Rights**. Pursuant to the Flint Ridge POA Covenants, Article VII.D.1.c, Mike Hope moved to suspend members' rights on delinquent accounts; duly seconded and carried.

## 8. **General Managers Report**, by Pat O'Brien

- 1. The grader has been inoperative for two weeks. We received the parts and are currently doing our own repairs. We hope to be back to grading and rolling next week.
- 2. Major repairs were also made to the backhoe as 6 of the rams needed to be re-sealed. Thank you to Mike Hope for taking them to his business and repairing them at no cost.
- 3. As soon as temperatures are warm enough, pothole repair will begin. Golf Course: I have been in contact with Jacob Gordon to become our golf course consultant for the foreseeable future. This is being done on a trial basis in place of hiring a golf course superintendent, which saves quite a bit of money.

- 11. <u>New Business</u>. Mike Hope moved to approve a payment of \$6,200 to Mark Edelman for removal of an RV and numerous other items from one lot. Duly seconded and approved

Mike Hope moved to approve up to \$18,000 for title-clearing work on selected lots. Duly seconded and approved. President Pat O'Kelley reported that 2 buyers are ready to purchase when available, and there is strong interest in several other lots. These lots may be sold for \$15,000 or more, but require a clear title. Lot sales should produce a good return on the cost of title clearing.
